More Updates from Whittier Schools

Manual High School:

- Manual recently celebrated the highest growth in daily attendance (+9%) and the largest decrease in chronic absenteeism (-32%) across all of DPS!
- Girls Soccer First home game Friday 3/15 at 4:30PM
- Baseball First home game is Tuesday 4/2

McAuliffe Manual Middle School:

- Students who achieved perfect attendance recently celebrated with a special lunch planned by the 6th grade math classes. After researching the cost per pupil at neighborhood options and considering student preference, the students selected McDonald's for their celebration.
- Early spring sports are starting soon! This season features girls' flag football and boys' volleyball.

Whittier ECE-8 events:

- Multicultural Night will be Thursday 3/21
- The school's Black Excellence Plan for 2023-24 focuses on students' social emotional health and academic growth in literacy. School leaders and staff are using data from a behavioral and emotional screening tool as well as a literacy progress monitoring tool to identify needs and provide the appropriate support, strategies, and interventions.
