

CYCLING RACE IN WHITTIER MIKE NIELDS MEMORIAL DENVER CITY CRITERIUM

Whittier will play host to one of Colorado's premier road cycling races. Formerly known as the Bannock Street Criterium, the race is in its 27th year and attracts amateur and professional level racers from across Colorado and the country. The race will also be the venue for the Bicycle Racing Association of Colorado Junior Criterium Championship races, showcasing youth racers ages 9–18.

The race is promoted by the Front Rangers Cycling Club, a nonprofit organization that since 1993 has been bringing cycling to urban youth in the Front Range through a variety of programs.

A criterium is a circuit or "lap" race where racers ride the same closed course multiple times. Typical criterium race distances are 15–25 miles. These races are designed for spectators since you'll be able to see the racers multiple times and the action is at high speed and in close quarters...fast and furious!

The FRCC appreciates the support from neighbors, the WNA, Manual High School and local businesses. The race has been planned to be a fun, safe, enjoyable event with minimal impact to neighbors.
